

POLICY FOR PROJECTS

APPLYING FOR FUNDING

This document outlines timelines for organisations applying to EOCA for funding, in order that the process is fair to all taking part and gives newcomers to the process equal opportunities to be successful:

- If the project has gained funding
- If the project has been shortlisted but not gained funding
- If the project has not been shortlisted

If a project has been funded -

The organisation can only apply for funding again after the current project has completed, and the final report has been accepted by EOCA.

If a project has been shortlisted twice and not gained funding either time -

EOCA asks that the organisation does not reapply for another 2 funding rounds (1 year).

If a project has applied on 3 occasions but never gained a position on the shortlist (even if the project has been amended, following feedback from EOCA) -

EOCA asks that the organisation does not reapply for another 3 funding rounds (18 months).
